Who Are WatchDOGS?

WatchDOGS are fathers, grandfathers, uncles, and other father-figures/male role models who volunteer for at least one day each year at an official WATCH D.O.G.S. school.

What do WatchDOGS do?

WatchDOGS volunteers perform a variety of tasks during their volunteer day including monitoring the school entrance, assisting with unloading and loading of buses and cars, monitoring the lunch room, or helping in the classroom with a teacher's guidance by working with small groups of students on homework, flashcards, or spelling.
