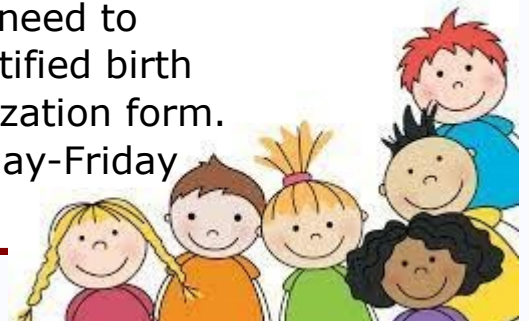
Parents,
